“EI Shaddai” - “the all sufficient one, or He who is more than enough.”

LK. 19:17 “...he came to himself.”

God expects us to rise up and act as He reveals TRUTH to us.

MT. 7:11 (KJV) - 11 If ye then, being evil,
know how to give good gifts unto your
children, how much more shall your Father
which is in heaven give good things to them
that ask him?

We are to place the truths of God's word in proper perspective.

JN. 8:32 (KJV) - 32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Freedom from the curse of poverty is God's desire for His children.

“Abundant Living” - is God’s idea!

MK. 10:29-30 (CEV) - 29 “Jesus told him: You can be sure that anyone who gives up home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or land for me and for the good news 30 will be rewarded. In this world they will be given a hundred times as many houses and

Brothers and sisters and mothers and children
and pieces of land, though they will also be
mistreated. And in the world to come, they will
have eternal life.”

LK. 6:38 (NLT) - 38 “Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full—pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back.”

JN. 10:10 (CEV) - 10 “A thief comes only to rob, kill, and destroy. I came so that everyone would have life, and have it in its fullest.”

“Abundance” means: “considerable resources; great quantity; to have riches.”

We are to THINK on “GOD’S ABUNDANCE.”

Heb. 11:6 (Ampl.) - 6 “But without faith it is impossible to [walk with God and] please Him, for whoever comes [near] to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He rewards those who [earnestly and diligently] seek Him.”

Gal. 4:7 (CEV) - 7 “You are no longer slaves. You are God’s children, and you will be given what he has promised.”

HOW DO WE ACHIEVE “GOOD SUCCESS?”

Success is NOT good within itself!

* We are to realize that God is interested in You as a Person. He wants a personal relationship with you.

Jas. 1:16-17 (KJV) - 16 “Do not err, my beloved brethren. 17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.”

* God wants you to WORSHIP HIM as a Person. He wants us to LOVE and to SERVE Him because of WHO HE IS - not for what He Does.

Jeremiah 9:23-24 (KJV) - 23 “Thus saith the Lord, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches:

24 But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me," I am the Lord which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the Lord."

God wants nothing but good for your life.
Jesus drew the line on Satan in JN. 10:10!
Jesus said to the Pharisees, JN. 8:44 and
they were “successful” men

JN. 8:44 (CEV) - 44 “Your father is the devil, and you do exactly what he wants. He has always been a murderer and a liar. There is nothing truthful about him. He speaks on his own, and everything he says is a lie. Not only is he a liar himself, but he is also the father of all lies.”

Money is NOT necessarily a sign of success.

PR. 10:22 (KJV) - 22 The blessing of the Lord,
it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with
it.

Good success is receiving what God has for you - with NO SORROW.

“Rich in what?” - In everything - that includes ALL THINGS and excludes NOTHING!

PS. 24:1 (KJV) - 24 The earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

Our heavenly father will always have
PLENTY!

II Cor. 9:8 (CEV) - 8 God can bless you with everything you need, and you will always have more than enough to do all kinds of good things for others.

There is NO FAILURE in this verse!

In Him there is TOTAL SUCCESS!

Phil. 4:19 (NLT) - 19 And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.

II Cor. 8:9 (KJV) - 9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.
