4 And Jesus *said to her, “Woman, [.] what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come.” 5 His mother *said to the servants, “Whatever He says to you, do it.” 6 Now there were six stone waterpots set there for the Jewish custom of purification, containing [.] twenty or thirty gallons each.

9 When the headwaiter tasted the water which had become wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter *called the bridegroom, 10 and *said to him, “Every man serves the good wine first, and when *the people* have 11 drunk freely, *then he serves* the poorer wine; but you have kept the good wine until now.”

Covenant

Covenant - a chosen relationship in which 2 parties make **BINDING** promises to one another... it is distinguished from a contract because it is a **PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP** which people enter into voluntarily.
